Plymouth School Sports Partnership	£3500	Autumn 2015	Pupils have the opportunity for inter-city events in all major sports (Level 2 competitions) and progression to Level 3 where successful. Staff has regular CPD and training updates. The school can access resources for the whole school, e.g. Bikeability, Balanceability, Indoor Rowing, dance mats and Teaching & Planning support from a PE Specialist teacher.
Sports Equipment	£2500	Autumn 2015	Refreshed and updated resources to deliver all requirements of the National Curriculum.
Supply/Transport Funding	£500	Ongoing	Reserve money to cover transport and supply costs where required.
Outdoor play equipment/improvements	£2375	Unallocated (Post October 2015)	Explore potential of static playground equipment, e.g. basketball hoops, football goals after installation of school perimeter fence.

Aims for PE 2015/16

- Youth Sport Trust Young Ambassador Peer Leaders Conference to inspire a cohort of ten leaders to role model and lead Change4Life Playground Challenges;
- Profile of PE to be sustained and developed to further promote engagement and positive dispositions towards healthy and active lifestyles through Twitter account @StPetersRCSPORT and impact of #YAPeerLeaders;
- Delivery of a GIRLS ONLY club (#ThisGirlCan) to be supported by #YAPeerLeaders;
- Sustained engagement with Level 2 School Games competitions through the Plymouth SSP with aspirations for progression to Level 3 competitions (e.g. Devon Winter School Games (e.g. Cross Country; Quicksticks Hockey; High 5 Netball) and Devon Summer School Games (e.g. Tri Golf; Quadkids, Mini Reds Tennis);
- Academic Council (RC Schools) PE Specialist teacher to deliver WHOLE STAFF INSET x 3 sessions across the academic year (Aut, Spr and Sum) with a focus on the delivery of the New PE National Curriculum and to support KS1 PE within curriculum time with planning, delivery and assessment (legacy of PE in KS1);
- Year 6 to receive Bronze Ambassadors training prior to #SchoolGames Day during National School Sports Week (20th-24th June);
- Year 6 to plan and lead a #SchoolGames Day assembly with Plymouth SSP as guest speakers.
