Plymouth School Sports Partnership	£3500	Autumn 2016	Pupils have the opportunity for inter-city events in all major sports (Level 2 competitions) and progression to Level 3 where successful. Staff has regular CPD and training updates. The school can access resources for the whole school, e.g.  Bikeability, Balanceability, Indoor Rowing, dance mats and Teaching & Planning support from a PE Specialist teacher.
Supply/transport funding	£1545	Ongoing	Reserve money to cover transport and supply costs where required, giving further opportunities to disadvantaged children for a wider range of events.
Real PE	£1995	Spring/Summer 2017	Provide fun and simple to follow Schemes of Work and support for Early Years Foundation Stage, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 practitioners that give them the confidence and skills to deliver outstanding PE.
Targeted Change 4 Life Club	£540	Spring 2017 - ongoing	A targeted Change 4 Life Club run by professionals in order to provide opportunities for children disaffected by PE and/or who would not typically attend a sport-related club.
Replenishment of curriculum resources and playground resources (inc. promotion of the Active Travel Crew)	£1168	TBC	Refreshed and updated resources to deliver all requirements of the National Curriculum (simply replenishing any damaged/lost equipment).  Continue to increase the range of stimulating playground equipment for promoting healthy, active lifestyles.  Look into prospect of procuring cycling equipment (e.g. bicycles, scooters, helmets, etc.) to promote active travel with workshops.
