Thank you all for your continued support of the school and your child in this ever changing time. Here are some brief updates and some news to share:

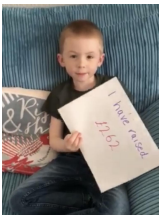
Lateral Flow Testing for Staff
