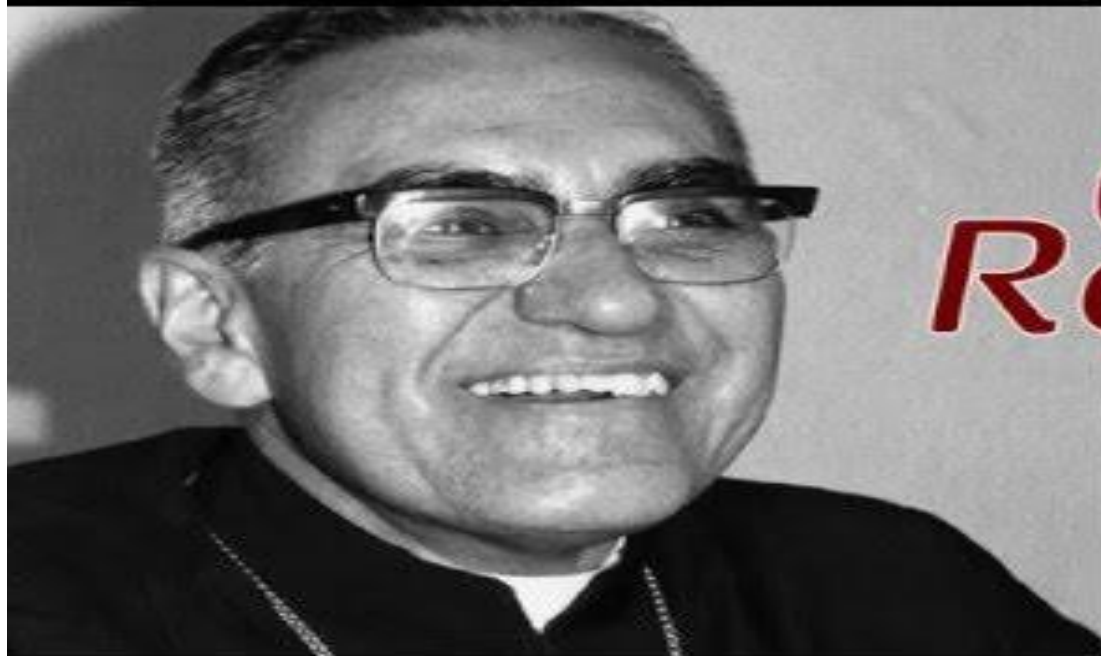

We too have demonstrated this virtue which is why we have achieved the Oscar Romero Award.

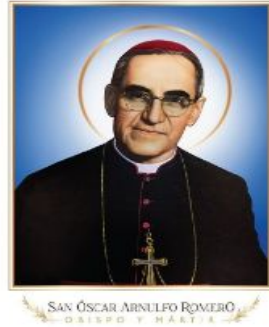

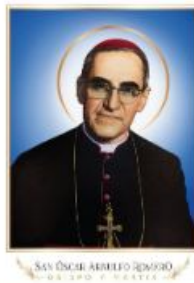

We have achieved level one of The Oscar Romero Award

At St. Peter's we are alert to the needs of others and seek justice for all within and beyond the school community. We regularly fundraise for charities such as CAFOD, Jeremiah's Journey, St. Vincent De Paul and local food charities.

Here are some of the things we have done to show that we promote **Catholic Social Teaching**, care for our common home and address poverty in our communities and and further afield.

We supported the 'Sleep on the floor' campaign raising awareness of homelessness in our city. Lots of children undertook this challenge.

In the Spring term 2022, we took part in the CAFOD Lent 'Walk for hunger'

We collect food for our local food banks.

We held a community kitchen where people in our school and local community can have a meal for free. This will happen again this week.

We are linked with Underhill Care home- we've sent Christmas cards, Easter cards, some children have visited residents and we welcomed them to our school for a cream tea.

We are also linked to older people at the Salvation Army- linking old and young together. We will resume our carpet curling team after half term. We have helped with their Christmas toy appeal, some children sorted presents and many of our families benefited from this appeal.

We are currently supporting the Parish Church with their Ukraine appeal for sanity and toiletry products.

We collected approx 40 boxes for the Ukrainian shoe box appeal- Nov 22.

Romero class held a cake sale and raised £110 for the CARITAS Ukrainian appeal.

We regularly take part in the 'Big Walk and Wheel' (to reduce carbon emissions)

We fundraise on Red Nose day mufti to support children who are less fortunate in our communities.

We held a Macmillan cake sale September 2022.
