#### Literacy:

Write recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed.

Spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the

#### Understanding the World:

Compare two or more items using the vocabulary of measure.

Use non-standard units of measure to measure then compare items.

Recognise quantities to 10 without counting.

Recall number bonds to 5 Recall some number bonds to 10

Recall some double facts.

## Subtraction

Explore subtraction number bonds

Subitise numbers to 10
Use part-whole models to 'break apart' 10 and identify the different bonds created.

Use knowledge of addition number bonds to 10

See the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction.
